Rockland County Youth Academy (Ages 12 & up)

For ages twelve to fourteen this academy introduces young adults to the world of Emergency Services. This 6-week program will introduce you to the Fire and Emergency Medical Services provided in Rockland County. You will receive classroom and hands-on training in firefighting, first aid and rescue operations. You will gain life-saving skills and become certified in Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). The Fire & EMS Youth Academy meets one evening each week and on Saturdays at the Rockland County Fire Training Center in Pomona, NY. Classes are forming for late spring / early summer!

Rockland County Explorers Post (Ages 14 & up)

For ages fourteen to sixteen the Fire Explorer's Program will take your interest in Fire Service to the next level. Gear and uniforms are provided; all you need is your willingness to learn. The Explorers meet on 2 Sundays a month from 6:00 pm - 9:00 pm. You will receive both hands on and classroom training. This is a great program to get you ready for joining your local department.
